DRAFT LEIGH PARISH COUNCIL MINUTES

MINUTES of the FULL COUNCIL MEETING of the LEIGH PARISH COUNCIL held on 19th April 2021, at 7:30pm. This meeting was held remotely in accordance with the Covid-19 Pandemic restrictions. The meeting was not recorded.

- 72. Apology for absence Cllr Everitt, Cllr Tomkins, SCC Cllr Clack, DCC Cllrs Bushnell and Huggins.
- 73. The **Minutes of the Full Council Meeting** held on 15th March 2021 was acknowledged as an accurate record. These are to be signed in person by JC at the first opportunity.
- 74. **Disclosure of Interests.** Cllrs Ames and Wilkinson both raised a declaration of interest on the Motions Orchard (77.2) due to being members of the Apple Press Group.
- 75. Parishioners Questions
 - 75.1. Nothing at present
- 76. **Crime Report** (Appendix A) JC read through the crime report attached. Incidents were noted.
- 77. Clerk Report/Matters Arising
 - 77.1. **Oak Processionary Moth** spraying. LM had been contacted by a contractor to gain access to spray the tree locations where the OPM nests were identified last year: Behind the pavilion and within the playground. They will spray the sites twice over the season with non-toxic moth specific insecticide. They will not require the playground to be closed for spraying. The cost is currently funded by the Forestry commission and will be covered for two years.
 - 77.2. **Motion Orchard Transfer**. It was noted that both parties were now obtaining signatures and that the Transfer document will be completed soon. It was proposed that a licence be drafted outlining the usage of the orchard with any potential users of the plot. All agreed this would be a sufficient contract and that a Lease would not be required.
 - 77.3. The **Leigh Charity Plant Sale** organisers had submitted a request to use the village green for their annual event due to take place on Saturday 22nd May from 2pm to 5pm. LM had shared the requirements with the organisers as outlined by Mole Valley District Council. It was agreed that if they have arranged an approved event management plan, a Covid-19 Risk Assessment and have acquired public liability insurance in advance of the event the Parish Council would grant permission.

Community

78. Community Projects/grants

- 78.1. **Leigh History Group (LHG)**. The clerk (LM) had spoken to the group regarding the details for issuing the agreed grant. It was proposed by LM that the group pay for the publication up front and send a copy of the invoice to LPC as evidence of expenditure. The grant will then be issued in the form of a cheque to the individual who has incurred the costs on behalf of the LHG. Regarding taking payment for the book sales, the options available were briefly discussed. It was proposed by PW that we investigate this in more depth and reconvene with more information.

Highways and Services

- 79. **Highway issues**. No issues currently. LM shared that a Surrey Highways survey is currently open, looking at resident's opinions on speed limits on rural roads. LM has circulated via social media. This closes on 30th April.
- 80. **Flooding.** It was noted there had been door to door surveys being carried out across various roads in Leigh. It was not clear as to their purpose at this stage.

 Amenities
- 81. **Playground Update**. In the absence of RT, JC thanked resident Tim Stevens for his contribution along with RT and RW in getting the benches and the wooden fort back in use. RW, the footpath officer raised the fact that users of the playground are filling up the dog waste bin with general rubbish. Currently there are no bins in the park and the provision of a litter bin(s) in the park was discussed. It was felt that should one be provided, it would end up becoming a problem in peak times: overflowing, drawing wasps, encourage more litter etc. The need for emptying the bin regularly would pose a logistical and possibly costly issue. It was felt that although currently many users were encouraged to tidy up and remove litter, the playground could do with signage for this.
 - 81.1. ACTION install signage encouraging users to take their rubbish home with them (and not use the dog bin for normal waste) (LM)
- 82. **Allotments**. LM has had a few enquiries recently for vacant plots. There is currently around four on the waiting list. Only one plot is vacant but it is in a very overgrown state.
 - 82.1. **ACTION LM and JC will arrange a site visit now the restrictions are opening.** Planning
