MINUTES of the FULL COUNCIL MEETING of the LEIGH PARISH COUNCIL held on 21st June 2021, at 7:30pm.

- 102. **Apology for absence had been received and accepted from** Cllr J Cambra, Cllr M Foulsham, Cllr M Everitt. DC Cllr M Huggins.
- 103. The **Minutes of the Annual General Council Meeting** held on 17th May 2021 was acknowledged as an accurate record and signed by PW.
- 104. **Disclosure of Interest**; SA and PW declared a non pecuniary interest in the orchard. LM reminded those present to redo their DOI forms and send through for resubmission to MVDC asap.

105. Parishioners Questions

- 105.1. Speed restrictions on NR. There had been two accidents on Newdigate Rd, one DUI and one collision with deer. Newdigate Road has become a racetrack. Could the roads be a 30 rather than a 40mph.
 - 105.1.1. ACTION Put in an enquiry regarding the speed limit with Surrey Highways. (LM)
- 105.2. Road signs left behind. There are various roadwork signs which have not been collected. (Newdigate Rd junction and one at NR/CH Road, Junes bloom and outside Hook Farm, Shellwood Rd and BCR.)
 - 105.2.1. ACTION Log with Surrey Highways via the portal (LM)
- 105.3. Trees on the Green. Various branches have been pulled off the trees on the green (Church Side)
 - 105.3.1. ACTION Ask contractor to tidy before the SSEIB judging day (Thurs 24th June).
- 106. **Crime Report** This had not been received in time. Clerk to circulate once in. (Appendix A)

107. Clerk Report/Matters Arising

- **107.1.** It was noted that the SSEIB judging was taking place on Thursday 24th June. (For information only). This year it was being hosted by LDCGS. Previously planned to be a desk-top entry it would now be in person. Kindly Jean Griffin will be representing the village on the day and showing them around.
- **107.2.** A family had approached the Parish Council requesting the PC consider them installing a memorial bench on the green for their late father. All agreed that this will require a site visit and depending on the location possible liaising with the Church. (LM)
- **107.3.** Cllr Wilkinson congratulated the Leigh Plant sale having raised £2645 for local groups. The organisers had kindly provided all the information requested and legally required in plenty of time.

Community

108. Community Projects/grants.

- **108.1.** Leigh Picnic. It had been noted that the LDCGS had advertised (via a maildrop) a community event being planned on the recreation ground on 18th July. The Council were surprised that no permission had been sought yet from the Parish Council although the Cricket Club were informed. Councillors also raised concern regarding the fact the current restrictions for Covid-19 would still be in place on that date.
 - 108.1.1. ACTION Contact for clarity from LDCGS regarding the event. Advise them they need to provide a Covid Risk Assessment (needs to be checked by the Environmental Department) and a copy of their Public Liability insurance. (LM)

108.2. Adria Kinloch kindly gave a brief update on the History Book publication. The final copy had not yet been signed off. Publish date TBC.

Highways and Services

- 108.3. **Highway issues** LM parised the prompt service from Surrey Highways. She had requested BCR verge cut on the corners of the village hall. They had attended very promptly. It was noted that at tree had come down on a van on BCR/NR.
- 108.4. **Flooding** It was noted that a water leak on Smallshill Rd was still there despite being reported by several residents.

Amenities

- 108.5. **Playground Update** (RT): Your Fund application there was now a request for full submission. RT has spoken directly with the grant team. He now needs to organise plans and obtain three quotes for the playground proposal.
 - Quote for repairs to access bridge. Clerk and JC had met with a local handyman and were awaiting his quote. He had suggested there was a new surface placed over the wooden sleepers. This would replace the chicken wire that is degrading and potentially sharp.
- 108.6. **Allotments:** LM and JC had visited the site last week to double check a plot swap request. The two plot holders are incredibly tidy and productive so the request has been approved. LM mentioned that the site generally is very over-grown and that it would be sensible to think about how the site could be tidied up (particularly the communal areas) and made more attractive. There were several areas and plots which were not being used currently. These could be improved, redrawn out and leased out.
 - 108.6.1. ACTION put together a proposal to enable the allotment site to be used more effectively. (LM/ME/JC)
- 108.7. **Green spaces:** The date has been fixed for the presentation and transfer of deeds from The Motion Family to Leigh Parish Council. It will take place in late July. A licence template had been prepared for the Apple Press Group by Leigh Parish Council. This licence will stipulate the usage and management of the Orchard.
 - 108.7.1. RESOLVED All present agreed to Adopt the proposed Licence for Motion Orchard/Apple Press Group.
 - 108.7.2. ACTION Sign approved licence and circulate. (PW/LM)
 - 108.7.3. ACTION Request Title Deed and plan for transfer day (Motion Orchard) (LM)
