# MINUTES of the FULL COUNCIL MEETING of the LEIGH PARISH COUNCIL held on 19<sup>th</sup> July 2021, at 7:30pm.

- 118. Apology for absence had been received and accepted from Cllr Mr M Everett.
- 119. The **Minutes of the Full Council Meeting** held on 21<sup>st</sup> June 2021 was acknowledged as an accurate record and signed by JC.
- 120. **Disclosures of Interest.** There were no notifications of DOI or changes to the Register of Interests.
- 121. Parishioners Questions
  - 121.1. Resident queried why Leigh Cricket Club had not cut the boundary grass on the recreation ground.
    - 121.1.1. ACTION: Contact Leigh Cricket Club to request they address this (LM)
  - 121.2. Resident observation regarding the Hedge at Old School House. The hedge has been cut back but is still overhanging the pavement.
    - 121.2.1. ACTION -Thank them for the effort cutting the hedge. Request that they take it back further. (LM)
- 122. Crime Report This had not been received in time. Clerk to circulate once in. (Appendix A)
- 123. Clerk Report/Matters Arising (Appendix A)
  - **123.1. Leigh Picnic (LDCGS):** the society had liaised with MVDC event team and produced all the documentation requested in time for the event to take place (18<sup>th</sup> July on the recreation ground).
  - **123.2. New stiles:** The SCC Right of Way team have yet to respond to the request for funding or support for the proposed stile into the recreation ground.
  - **123.3. Speed reduction:** The proposal to Surrey Highways for reducing the speed limit on the stretch of Newdigate Rd to between BCR and Clayhill Rd was also awaiting response.
  - **123.4. Dawes Green Layby:** There had been no success in identifying whether the old deeds show ownership of the Dawes Green layby.
    - 123.4.1. ACTION: contact Surrey County Council Property Team to ascertain if they have ownership. If they do investigate adopting it. (LM)
  - 123.5. Tree Survey phase: it was agreed that it would be prudent to get quotes for the next phase of tree works highlighted by the Tree Survey in 2020.
    - 123.5.1. ACTION: obtain quotes from 2 or 3 contractors for the next phase of works. (LM)

#### Community

#### 124. Community Projects/grants.

124.1. AK updated that the History of Leigh publication was being finalised and should be ready to launch soon.

#### **Highways and Services**

- 125. **Highway issues** The roadwork signs reported last month have been collected from most sites in a timely manner.
- 126. **Flooding** JC met with the residents nearest the pump house on SmallsHill Rd. It was felt there had been more interest and attendance to the pump house recently. Sadly, the last heavy rain resulted in

flooding of their garden including sewage. It was noted that Thames Water have funded the investigations that are currently going ahead. It was felt it would be helpful to understand the data being collected and any management plans. Residents were unsure if the tankers had been in attendance. Foul waste was coming up from the drain at the end of Flanchford Rd and inspection covers showed that levels were high. RW reported that there were two blocked surface water drains. It was felt that lots of silt and roots probably need clearing from drains and there was concern regarding the run-off from the land drains on the farmland installed many years ago. RT felt it was probably time to request SH look to clear some of the drains and ditches Surrey CC was responsible for as they had not been in attendance for a couple of years.

126.1. ACTION – send on request for drain clearing to Surrey Highways (RT pls to send on to LM).

#### **Amenities**

- 127. **Playground Update** (RT): Currently obtaining proposals from suppliers for the 'Your Fund' application. We need three proposals for the application. There are some exciting options being explored, including local suppliers. All are sympathetic to the nature of the playground.
- **128. Allotments:** The project to reshape the plots needs further thought and might require assistance and support from the plot holders.
- 129. **Green spaces:** 
  - **129.1. Memorial Bench:** It was felt the proposed site at the fence with the Green and the church yard would need further consideration. The dog waste bin, the bin and the removable fence were all possible problems.
    - 129.1.1. ACTION: attend a site visit for the bench on the green to propose to the family (LM/JC)

- **133.1.** Bunce Common Hall is closed for the planned subsidence work. They have allowed to the end of August for the school year reopening.
- **133.2.** RW has been requesting quotes for the new stile on the corner of Newdigate Rd. He is also investigating the cost to replace the gate with a new hedge. (RW)
- 133.3. The Parking Liability sign at Dawes Green Layby has been bashed. RW is going to sort and send through any costs incurred to LM.
- 133.4. The Gatepost around the pavilion driveway has been nudged out of line. This is likely to have been a refuse truck. It doesn't appear to affect the gate shutting though.
- 133.5. It was suggested that we put in a dog waste sign on the gate by the pavilion as there was a noticeable amount of waste being left by dog owners recently. (LM)

134. **Welcome Pack for new residents:** It was noted that Cllrs Wilkinson and Foulsham are creating a welcome pack for new residents. The archive one is very out of date so needs improving and updating. (In future this will sit under community on the agenda.)
