- 351. **The Minutes of the Full Council Meeting** held on Monday 17th October were approved and signed by Mrs Joanne Willoughby.

357. Highways and Services

357.1. Highways

357.1.1. Speed survey booked for Newdigate Road. Clerk is awaiting a date for the survey. This is usually a Spring activity.

357.2. Flooding

357.2.1. JW had noted that there had been vans in attendance at Smalls Hill Rd due to the recent wet weather. It was noted that SES had located a leak on the boundary near Smalls Hill Road. Regarding the October request for FOI for water survey report - Clerk asked for clarity. Once this has been received, she can submit.

357.3. Transport

357.3.1. Gatwick. No real update currently. There are meetings coming up. Both Gatwick and CAA have been working on incorrect flight information for at least a decade. The lobby groups felt that class action, could be taken by residents who had planned to live in the area but under misinformation. Pressure driven from all sides on changes to Route3 and 4. MF would update once he knew more.

358. Amenities

358.1. Playground:

- 358.1.1. Mole Valley about playground inspection. Clerk to check when this was happening.
- 358.1.2. Find out about about Rospa Training and circulate dates to Mr Brockwell and Cllr Tomkins.

358.2. Allotments:

- 358.2.1. LM to Update the website to reflect no vacancies. Rent was all in for the next year.
- 358.2.2. RW suggested adding a pond to assist drainage. He had had a quote from a local contractor for information only. For a Pond sited to the Left hand side, size 4x2x2m deep putting the spoils to the side it would cost in the region of £1200. Clerk will share the ground flooding documents to assist in siting. Councillors thanked RW for his time. They will consider the costs.

- 360.3. **Agreement of Precept levels for 2023-24.** At the finance meeting held in November it was agreed that the precept level would remain the same year on year for residents. There has been a small reduction in the number of households paying council tax so the actual precept received by the Parish Council would drop slightly while the cost to households remains the same.

 - 360.4.1. Co-Option of Councillor Brockwell. It was proposed that Mr Graham Brockwell be co-opted onto the council. He had submitted interest. Clerk asked the Councillors to declare a show of hands.

 RESOLVED: All present agreed to co-opt Mr Brockwell. Clerk will send through all the documents necessary and at the next Full Council meeting (in February) he will sign the Declaration of office book. The Council Chair welcomed him to the Council.

This would be an in person meeting provisionally suggested for Monday 16th January at 7:30pm. Clerk to check and publicise. It was felt that like other parishes it would be sensible to promote with residents rather than solely groups as residents may get more engaged.
